2. Outline of Technical Session

1) International Seminar on Tunnel – Challenge and Opportunity for Urban and Mountain Tunneling

In this seminar, Prof. Ishida, Tsukuba Univ., gave a lecture about the Japanese challenge toward new infrastructure development policy. And Mr. Shichijo, Senior Director, Overseas Project Division, Policy Bureau, MLIT, introduced efforts and proposal to build a sustainable Partnership between Indonesia and Japan. PWRI introduced state-of-the-art of tunnel technology in Japan. Shotcrete technology and Jakarta MRT Project were also introduced by Japanese member. From Indonesia site, latest situation of the tunnel project in Indonesia was introduced. Many participants, such as local government officer, engineer and students, eagerly discussed about tunnel technology of Indonesia and Japan.



2) Discussion on "Tunnel"

The progress and contents of the technical guideline on auxiliary method for tunnel which had been written jointly were discussed. It was confirmed that we set the goal of writing completion and holding seminar. A future research cooperation roadmap was developed, and it was confirmed that the discussion about the technical guideline of facility, design and construction of the road tunnel and the shotcrete technology will be started in 2014. In addition, It was also confirmed that PWRI will accept the researcher from IRE to be continued in future.



3. Reference (History of the Cooperation)

The National Institute for Land and Infrastructure Management (NILIM) and the Institute of road Engineering (IRE) signed cooperation arrangement in Indonesia, February 2014.

Under this memorandum, the NILIM and IRE will continually share research information by, for example, jointly holding technical seminars and will actively exchange researchers to strengthen links between NILIM and Asia and to form international human networks, thereby providing technical supports for the growth in Asia.
