COLLABORATION BETWEEN ITST OF VIETNAM AND NILIM TOOK ACTIONS!

H.E Mr.Ngo Thinh Duc, Permanent Deputy Minister of Transport, Socialist Republic of Vietnam visited NILIM on 21st in May with Director General of Institute of Transport Science & Technology, MOT and other high ranked officials, to discuss the possibility of collaboration between two countries in the sphere of research regarding Road and Transport Systems.

At the meeting, Mr.NISHIKAWA, Director Genaral of NILIM made a remark of there being no person here but could take the cooperation into actions as so much of the people found the affinity and similarity of Vietnam and Japan, especially in dairy life of the people-foods, rice culture etc.- having a basic beautiful value of working under the sunshine. All participants understood the collaborative action to be started with so great leaderships as to be deployed into the prosperity of the two countries.



As the conclusion, we identified three points as bellows;

- (1) ITST and NILIM decided to conduct cooperative research on mutual interests including Road and Transport to promote the economical benefits of the two countries and the welfare of their people.
- (2) In respect of (1) as a first step a delegation will be sent from NILIM to ITST around in September to increase its understanding of the condition of related infrastructure in Vietnam, and so that the details of this delegation will be arranged by the two institutes.

(3) The collaboration activities will be promoted through the joint workshop and the exchange of technological information and other measures, especially considering the fact that middle/young researchers should be involved into these activities to deepen the collaboration and friendship in the future.

This visiting was closed with the confidence of hastening successfully the cooperation between ITST and NILIM in the future as there being so much common in both countries as showed above.
