Acceptance of Training for the World Bank Cambodia Technical Assistance Project ~Conducting Training on Local Roads for the Ministry of Rural Development Officials of Cambodia~

The NILIM accepted 10 trainees from the Ministry of Rural Development of Cambodia on Tuesday, September 12, 2023 at the request of the World Bank Global Facility for Disaster Reduction and Recovery (GFDRR), Tokyo Disaster Risk Management Hub, and provided technical assistance training.

This training course was organized by the World Bank with the support of the "Japan-World Bank Joint Program for Mainstreaming Disaster Risk Management", which provided technical assistance to the Ministry of Rural Development of the Government of Cambodia to improve road access in rural areas of Cambodia and the resilience of local roads to natural disasters and climate risks. As part of this technical cooperation, examples of road maintenance and management in Japan, as well as the latest technology and management were introduced for use in the maintenance and management of local roads in Cambodia.

In the technical assistance training in NILIM, two lectures were given on "Design and Maintenance of Pavements in Japan" and "Bidding and Contracting System for Public Works," and the facility tour of "Test Track" of approximately 6.2 km per lap and "Pavement Test Field" were conducted.
